The use of plasters in school

Dear Parents and Carers,

Following a review of advice from the Health and Safety Executive (HSE), the use of plasters for the purposes of first aid will be reinstated from Tuesday 19th April. The decision to use a plaster will be made by a trained first aider who deems it a necessary part of treatment, to prevent infection of minor cuts and grazes. Plasters will be purchased by Castle Hills Primary Academy and these will be latex free, with a low allergy adhesive.

Please be aware that plasters will not be provided by school to cover children's earrings.

If, for any reason, you feel that your child(ren) should not receive a plaster for the purpose of first aid, please contact school to confirm this.
