- **Friday 24th June** – Castle Hills Primary Academy's Jubilee Fair and Grand Raffle Draw. Our fair promises to be an afternoon of fun with fairground rides including carousel and surfing simulator. A variety of food and drink stalls will keep you full throughout the afternoon whilst local business's selling a wide range of goods will be available. It promises to be magical with our very own magician performing at **1.30pm and 3.30pm** and providing magic lessons over the course of the day. Children can win prizes on hook a duck, guess the name of the teddy and how many sweets in the jar. Representatives from the Army will be on site with an obstacle course and children can compete in a football shootout.
